**Meeting with representatives of the Village Church to discuss the constitution**

The Charity Commission does not consider that a constitution is needed. Rev Day pointed out that the Church legal department would require a constitution. Also that a constitution would be needed for fund raising. The Chairman undertook to amend the constitution which will then be submitted to the Charity Commission when it will be stressed that the constitution is necessary to allow the future of the Village Hall to move forward.

**2009/2010 Budget Figures.** Parish Councillors were issued with a set of budget figures for 2009/10. The Precept has been set for £17,000. The budget was proposed by Susan Walsh and seconded by Lee Mason. The form for Selby Council was signed by the Chairman and a member.

**Lorries and Drug problems.** No Lorries have been reported. There have been no problems with drug users. The farmer has spread 3 loads of manure to discourage them and Susan Walsh has regularly checked the site

**Planning**

Apple Blossom Farm –application to remove the condition which specifies that the entrance/access should be on to Burn Lane. The Parish Council do not approve this removal of condition. The Parish Council tried to get the condition enforced.

Stockhill House-removal of barns and application for housing on the site. The Parish Council had a site visit to the area and agreed that the barns should be removed and replaced by dwellings,

Bungalow rear of Roselea 58 Brigg Lane has been approved.

Extension to Sandpit Farm Selby Road has been approved

**Proposal that the Parish Council buy land for use of motor bike riders.** Matthew Whittaker posted an e-mail on the web site on this matter.
