English Village Salads: Ian Arundel attended the meeting on behalf of English Village Salads. He explained to the meeting that the site had been taken over by Bakkover. The site comprises English Village Salads and Yorkshire Fresh Salads. Yorkshire Fresh salads deal mainly in fruit and it is probably their lorries that come through the village. Ian asked to be informed about any lorries seen in the village and he will deal with the matter. There will be an update of the matter at the next meeting. Village Hall:
