Village Hall the Parish Council and representatives of the Church will meet to discuss the situation and sort out a future programme of action. The Parish plan shows strong support for a Village Hall but it is vitally important that there is support from the Village. The next village newsletter will ask for support from residents. A working committee is needed and village volunteers. If these are not forthcoming the Parish Council may consider resigning from the Village Hall trusteeship. The clerk to write to Charity Commission with back history and ask for further advice.
