Lorries through village There are still problems with lorries coming through the village. Ian stressed that in order to deal with the matter he needs the registration number, time and date seen. He gave his mobile phone to James so that he could report sightings straight away.

Concern was expressed that drug dealing was taking place in the wooded area not far from the dog bin and near to the old den. Ian was asked if he could arrange to re fence this area. The last time there was a problem EVS arranged with local farmer to spread manure on the site and Ian suggested that they used this method again and this was approved by the parish council.

It was also reported that EVS employees have been seen buying cider at lunchtime from the mini-market. The concern was that employees are not sober when they return to work.

Minutes The minutes from the August meeting were approved and signed as a true record.

Bus Stop Mr Hall attended the meeting to put his point of view about the bus stop near his home. He was told by the police that it is illegal to block the end of a drive .He had tried several years ago to arrange with North Yorkshire Highways that a bus shelter and a bus stop was put in a about 20 yds down from his property but this had been refused by the Parish Council and when the matter of a shelter was raised again there were no longer any funds available.Mr Hall is concerned about a bus stop outside his home as a few years ago a boy was knocked down by a car outside of his home and it is important that this should never happen again.

Mr Hall also stated that drug dealer's stand outside his drive and he is concerned for the youths who visit his own home to spend time with his own children.

It was decided that the clerk would speak to Highways and ask if a bus stop sign could be erected 20-30 yards down from Mr Hall property. There would be a kerb at that point which would make alighting from the bus easier for passengers. The clerk to request a site meeting with councillors.

Play park it has been report that youths have been drinking in the play park. The subject of which areas were to be targeted for the alcohol exclusion zone was discussed.
