Minutes The minutes of the meeting of 26 September were approved and signed..

Financial Statement; current Account Deposit Account 11,453-56

There were no declarations of interest. The clerk signed the cheques with Mrs Walsh. New account signatories are being set up following the resignation of Mr Lewis.

Alcohol Free Zone; Tim Grogan the Licensing Officer from Selby District Council was invited to talk to the Council on setting up an alcohol free zone. An Alcohol free zone is community delivered and supported by the police. It is up to the Parish Council to decide what areas they want the zone to cover.

It was resolved that the Parish Council wished to set up an Alcohol Free Zone

Complaints were raised by residents about anti social behaviour in the village and Mr Grogan told residents that they must complain to the police and to ask for a log number when they complained. This will ensure that all complaints are logged.

Mr Grogan said that Police support is needed before we can set up the Alcohol free zone Inspector David Pegg had promised to attend the meeting but he did not arrive. The clerk was asked to write to Inspector Pegg expressing the Parish Council's disappointment in his non-attendance and asking when he would be able to attend the meeting.

Mr Grogan also informed the Parish Council that the Community Safety Unit had a mobile CCTV unit and suggested that the Parish Council applied to use it.

Village Hall The chairman and vice chairman held a fact finding meeting with the church prior to the meeting. They wished to ascertain the plans of the church should the project go ahead.

The scheme is subject to public consultation and approval. The Church's plan is to flatten the Village hall and rebuild a new structure. The new building would comprise two areas. One for the church and one use as a Village Hall.

The new building would be managed by a joint committee of Church members and residents Provided that there is approval for this scheme it could take the church up to 2 years to build

Mosquito: the mosquito has been installed but it is not effective. Clerk to speak to Mr Busby.

Village Playground: the problems in the play park appear to be easing.
