It was resolved that the Parish Council would defer the decision on the Village Hall until the next meeting to allow the Church Team to make their comments.

The Village Hall grass will be kept tidy. The clerk to ask Mr Spetch to repair the broken window.

**Play Park:** Sue Walsh has spoken to Record Playgroups re the siting of a youth shelter in the park. It is proposed that it should replace a bench. There will be money available for a shelter. It might be possible to install a larger shelter.

**Jag Meeting** Sue Walsh and Eileen Neale attended the Jag meeting. Thanks to Sue Camblesforth Village issues have been made high priority.
