The Parish Council books The books have been returned by the Internal Auditor Dianne Dumbell. The audit sheet was completed and signed ready for dispatching the books to Mazars.

Mayfair Security: the clerk stated that she had received a few letters in response to the article in the newsletter. However the Parish Council felt that the Village was not getting value for money from Mayfair **and it was resolved that the service would be cancelled from the middle of September**

Neighbourhood Watch as the Village will be without Mayfair Security it was suggested that the Parish Council should try and encourage the setting up of a Neighbourhood Watch scheme and that some information would be posted on the web site

Playpark. The Clerk to order the Tidy Bear. As she will be unable to transport it from her house the clerk requested assistance with moving it to the play park

Lighting Plan NYCC has issued a new lighting plan for the village.

Tree Preservation Orders the Parish Council will look at applying for TPO orders for the trees in the park at the next meeting.

Meeting with John Grogan MP

Eileen Neale, John Bedworth and the clerk attended the meeting with John Grogan MP with members of Carlton Parish Council and other officials with a view to improving facilities for the youth in the village. The Village School is willing to use the outside classroom for youth activities period. The North Yorkshire Youth Leader will check the Village Hall for use in the interim. He said there would be no problem in getting a Youth Leader. There is funding available. However there is a shortage of volunteers. John Bedworth will get in touch with John Grogan re the promised report of the meeting.

Youth Bus the clerk is still awaiting a report from Kate the Youth Bus Worker. It was felt that the bus needed to be better advertised/

Planning:

Equestrian Centre Hardenshaw Lane-his application has been withdrawn

69 Brigg Lane-The appeal has been dismissed-however the Inspector commented that a suitable dwelling could be acceptable.

68 Brigg Lane-a new application has been submitted. The Parish Council objects to the dwelling. Their objections based on the appeal judgement.

Barn Conversion at 10 Brigg Lane Parish Council did not support the application on safety grounds. Access on to Brigg Lane is unsuitable (this taken in conjunction with the second application see below)

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3 dwellings to rear of 10 Brigg Lane-The Parish Council objected to the application on safety grounds.

1. The access exits on to Brigg Lane is unsuitable as it is near dangerous bend
2. There is no allowance for on street parking
3. The bus stops outside the site
4. Visitors would either use dangerous on street parking. Or they would park in the Village Hall car park. Parking in the Village Hall would adversely affect the Village hall as they have insufficient parking for their own functions.
5. The site would be overdeveloped.

Erection of a detached dwelling on land adjacent to 6 Brigg Lane-objections on safety grounds. Objections on highway safety grounds..

Retention of Elliott Prefabricated Unit 1384 at Camblesforth Community School-no objections

Planning Contravention at Cobblecroft Farm-awaiting further information from the Enforcement Officer

Lorries through Village-complaints of EVS lorries using Brigg Lane. Clerk to contact EVS and ask them to deal with the matter. Also to ask Highways to erect directional signs on the Selby Road.
