Minutes of 15 August 2006 the minutes of the meeting were approved and signed

. Drug taking at the rear of the shops on Croft Road-it has been reported that a group of young people are taking drugs at the rear of the shop. The clerk was asked to contact PC Chris Ryan and also to speak to the Crime and Disorder Officer at Selby DC for advice. The clerk has been asked to speak the head teacher Mrs Parker.

Proposed bus stop on Brigg Lane; Mr Hall Jnr spoke Sarah Hutchinson with regard to a bus stop some months ago. He agreed to the placing of a bus stop but away from the front of his property at 2 Grange Cottages. He has not heard anything further from Ms Hutchinson with regards to the erection of the bus stop. He would like the matter to proceed as he is having problems with people using his drive while they wait for buses. The clerk was asked to contact Sarah Hutchinson NYCC for an update on the situation.

Appeal by Mr Ibbotson.Mr Ibbotson has lodged an appeal to lift the planning condition that allows the church to use an area of Mr Ibbotsons land for parking. This condition is not de to come in to force until the site is complete. The Parish Council has not received any details on the date of this appeal. Mr Ibbotson requested a copy of the April minutes. The clerk was asked to forward these.

Neighbourhood Watch the clerk has experienced problems in contacting PC R Scott.

Street Lights the ivy covering the streetlight on Brigg Lane has covered up the light again.

Camela Lane the overhanging trees on Camela Lane are causing problems to vehicles that are resulting in the road surface breaking up. The clerk to contact Dave Fowler at NYCC Highways again.

Willow Tree 10 Brigg Lane. Michael Harrison Trees Officer wrote to the Parish Council requesting that they consider the removal of the willow tree on the condition that a suitable tree is put in its place. The owner feels that the removal of the leylandii hedge will destabilise the willow tree. **It was resolved by the Parish Council to approve this course of action providing that a suitable tree replaces the willow tree.**

Youth Bus the clerk received a report from Kate the Youth Worker in charge of the Youth Bus. Kate and her colleague visited the village over 10 weeks for 2-hour sessions one day a week. They hosted 20 young people of ages ranging from 13-16.They asked the young people what facilities for young people they would like in the village. Dance groups, Drop in Groups and Discos were suggested.

Returfing the 5 a side pitch. A local resident came to the meeting with a group of Young people. They requested that the five a side pitch is returfed with astro turf. It was pointed out that the Parish Council had wanted to do this originally but that the cost was too high. **It was resolved by the Parish Council to have the football pitch turfed.**

In order to raise funds for the astro turf it will be necessary to form a committee. Sue Walsh will check the price of turf and inform the clerk. She will also look into the current prices for astro turf

Planning

Barn conversion at 10 Brigg Lane.

This is a resubmission of the previous application with amendments. The Parish Council did not approve the application on the grounds that the exit from the site is unsuitable as it is in the proximity of a blind bend.

Erection of dwellings to the rear of 10 Brigg Lane

This is a resubmission of the previous application with amendments.
The Parish Council did not approve the application.

1. It was felt that the access was unsuitable so near to a blind bend. If these houses were built there would be a much greater volume of traffic exiting and entering the site in a potentially dangerous area.
2. Lack of on sit parking for visitors. In an area where there is a limited amount of on street parking it would become a problem. Visitors would use the undersized Village Hall car park that would create a problem for the Village Hall users.
3. The bus stop is situated directly outside the wall of the development. The stop is well used by Children, Students and villagers.
4. The site is overdeveloped.
