Minutes; - The minutes of the meeting of 20 February 2007 were approved and signed by the Chairman

Village Hall: The Insurance for the Village Hall has been paid and is valid until 30 May 2007

The Village Hall Committee did not sign off the records and close the accounts. The Charity status has not been closed. A meeting must be called to sign off the Village Hall accounts. Susan Walsh to provide the paperwork for this.

The clerk has been approached with regard to the purchase of the bar equipment in the Village Hall. Parish Councillors have approved this but clerk expressed her reservations as to the legality of this course of action. The Clerk instructed to approach Mr Townsley and see if he is still interested. The Chairman will meet with Mr Townsley.

The clerk has contracted the Village Hall with regard to arranging an appointment concerning the Village Hall but has not received a reply.

Play Park: The time to apply for the remaining Section 106 money will end on 12 May. Sue Walsh to speak to the representative of Playdale and ask if we can add any more equipment to the obstacle course.

Energy Path. The clerk to write to the Power Station. Mrs Walsh to provide name **Street Light outside the Play Park.** This light is to be enhanced to improve quality of light. Parish Council will receive half the cost of this work from Community Safety.

Lorries through the Village; there is still a problem with lorries coming through the Village. The clerk has written to Mr Kearney the Managing Director of the site. The clerk will also speak to the police for advice as the Highways Department do not intend to erect any additional signage

Mosquito at Shops: This matter was discussed. The Clerk to apply to the Central CIPS for assistance with the cost. The Councillors took a vote on the matter. Four

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Parish Councillors were in favour of providing the Mosquito and one was against it. It was decided to help provide the mosquito

The group who are looking to provide a fence around the shops have asked if they collect the money could the Parish Council pay the account and also refund the VAT. The Parish Councillors approved the use of the bank account but not the refund of the VAT. It was suggested by Councillors that the VAT could go towards the Purchase of the Mosquito.

Councillors asked for their comment to be noted.
