Tree Preservation Orders the Parish Council might need to apply for TPO orders for the trees in the park.

Planning application:

1. Application to fell a sycamore tree at 12 Brigg Lane for safety reasons. The Parish Council supported the applicant because of the safety aspect.
2. Proposed erection of an extension to the side elevation of 35 Millfield Drive.the Parish Council had no comments to make.
3. Application for the proposed construction of fishing pond, storage buildings car parking area and siting of touring caravans on land at Cobblewood Farm.

The Parish Council thought the site unsuitable for the following reasons:

- The site is not large enough for the proposed development.

- The pond is not large enough to be viable and the amount of parking exceeds the proposed usage.
- The site enter/exits on to a fast road. The road is a busy thoroughfare and turning caravans at his point could cause problems.
- No mention of the amount of caravans that the site will hold when completed.
- There are no facilities for the amount of people who appear to be envisaged to use the site going by amount of car parking.
- The site plans do not match. There is some query as to which field is to be developed.
