County Emergency Scheme; Parish Councillors did not consider that this scheme was a worthwhile scheme and did not wish to be involved.

Street Lights; Light CM46 is out and needs reporting. The Parish Council will look at the lighting contract next year.

Play Park: the new gates should be in place by November.

The Youth Team have asked for lighting in the Play Park but it was pointed out that this is not possible

The Youth Bus is working well and is very successful.

Bus stop in Brigg Lane; It is likely that the stop will not be put in the requested place. There has been a local complaint that was considered valid by NYCC so the plans need to go back for planning permission.
