**Response from Charity Commission concerning the Village Hall** The Charity Commission state that the land is held on trust and were the land to be sold the trustees would need to purchase new land. They referred to clause 13 of the Deed of Gift. The Charity Commission asked the following questions of the trustees.

In the event of the Church /Village Hall being built

Who would own the building?

Who would administer the building?

The Charity Commission did not answer the question asked by the Parish Council

Than in the event that the Parish Council arranged to demolish the hall would the money spent to demolish the building be returned to the Parish Council if the land was subsequently sold by the Charity Commission? The clerk to contact the Charity Commission again on this matter

The Parish Council felt that the matter regarding the churches interest in the Village Hall site be clarified as soon as possible as it had gone on some considerable time and that a positive answer was needed by the Church by the end of the year.

**Play park**-the parents of the child who was injured falling from the swing are suing the Play Park Committee. There was discussion as to whether the swing should be removed from the play park.

This would be a practical move as at present she is the only member left from the original play park committee. It would be more practical for the decisions for the play park to be shared rather than being the responsibility of one person.*

***The Youth workers** want to bring their bus into the play park but they are unable to enter the park from the road as the gate is not wide enough. The Parish Council have had a quote from Records to widen the gate but it was rather high and they are now looking for a cheaper option. Susan Walsh is going to investigate the other options. The Youth team have planned a number of summer activities for the village young people.*

***Field at Barlow Lane end.** The Parish Council have approved the ploughing of the field for Mr Hayward. The clerk has been asked to write to him and reiterate that he must not sublet or share the field. The clerk to speak to Ron Hinch about the ownership of the trees surrounding the field.*

***Street Light Brigg Farm Court** this light has not been repaired the clerk to contact Tarmac again.*
