Village Hall Working Group: In response to the Newsletter appeal four volunteers attended the meeting. Terry Sykes explained the history of Village Hall. It was agreed that Fiona would arrange a meeting with Rev.Linda for the members of the working group.

An email has been received from the Charity Commission. The Parish Council will be unable to reclaim costs if they arrange to demolish the Village Hall. Members felt that the Parish Council should have a meeting with the Charity Commission. The clerk was asked to arrange this.

Vandal Damage on the Selby Road: A caravan window two car windscreens and a bus shelter have been damaged .The Police have been informed and have visited the residents. The damage to the bus shelter has been reported to NYCC.Councillor Spetch emphasised the importance of attending the CEF meetings to report local problems. Budget Meeting: It was resolved to set the 2010/2011 precept at 15,000.

Salt Bins: the salt bins were well used during the snowy period. The problem was that NYCC ran out of salt stock and were therefore unable to supply salt bins. The Parish Council are going to look into the practicalities of providing salt for the bins. A local resident requested a salt bin be installed on Pinewood Drive and this was approved.
