**Casual Vacancy:** Christopher Lewis handed in his resignation prior to the meeting. Kevin Wild was proposed as Chairman by Susan Walsh and seconded by Eileen Neill and Susan Walsh was proposed as Vice Chairman.

**Minutes;** - The minutes of the meeting of 21 August 2007 were approved by the meeting and signed by the Chairman.

**Lorries through Village:** There have been more Lorries through the village in this past month than the previous month. Ian Arundel apologised on behalf of his company. He is trying to take steps to stop the Lorries using Brigg Lane but he has logistical problems. The clerk was asked to write to Paul Sheppard Highways and ask when the new signs on the Selby Road would be installed and would they be multi-lingual. Ian said his company might be prepared to sponsor part of the cost towards the signs.

**Play Park**

A letter has been received from Linda and Andrew Winfield. They are having problems with the new equipment in the playpark. Youths are in the park until the early hours making a lot of noise and this is disturbing residents. The police had been called but they left to deal with another call. Linda also believes that there is incidents of drug taking in the park as foil wraps have been found. Kevin Wild said that the Parish Council would allow time to see if the situation in the park improved. If it did not the appropriate action would be taken.

Sue Walsh pointed out that it is important for residents to complain direct to the police as then the matter will go on record. Linda said that she was willing to put a box for complaints in the Post Office. This would help the Parish Council to monitor the situation.

The Parish Council was asked to clean up the play park. The clerk was asked to arrange this

Terry Sykes reported that we had a new Community Police man in place of Chris Ryan. He learnt this at the School Governors Meeting. The Clerk was asked to write to Inspector Dave Pegg informing him that residents were unhappy with the policing situation. And that Parish Council were unhappy that that they had not been informed that there was a new Community Policeman.

It was agreed that the clerk should approach Tim Grogan Licensing Officer Selby District Council re the establishment of an alcohol exclusion zone.
