**Minutes** The minutes of the meeting of 3 January 2008 were approved and signed

**Alcohol exclusion zone** there was no-one from the police available so the matter was not discussed.

**Mosquito on mini market** The clerk has received the information. She has spoken to Jubb Electricians at Snaith and asked them to look at the mosquito and adjust it..

**Village Hall** the matter has not moved much further forward. The clerk is awaiting information from the Charity Commission.A letter was received from Mr D Cheshire and Mr J Rockliff.

They proposed that the village hall should be offered for sale for the erection of detached bungalows. The purchaser to be responsible for the demolition of the village hall. The merits of this scheme would be to relieve the Parish Council funding and insuring the hall. The poor condition of the site is a matter that also needs to be addressed.

It was pointed out that a recent article in the Selby Times said that the Church was prepared to fund half the cost of the demolition. This comment is incorrect.

**Plastics bin** a new bin has been installed on the site. Onyx will check the site weekly. The situation could improve as Carlton and Drax are to get Recycling bins for plastic.
