Minutes; - The minutes of the meeting of 3 January 2007 were approved and signed by the Chairman

A letter has been sent to Mark Queenan advising that he is no longer on the Parish Council as he has not attended a meeting of the Parish Council for 6 months.

Street Light Consultation: a consultation form was sent to houses likely to be affected by the enhancing of the street light by the park. Of the forms that were returned the majority felt that an improvement to the light would benefit them and reduce the fear of crime. The clerk to ask Mr Brooksbank to do the work on the light and also to deal with the light by the slow sign.

Gas Gun bird scarer; Mr Spetch telephoned the clerk after he received her letter. He stated that he was using the gas gun to protect his livelihood and would not leave the gun working any longer than necessary.

Trees on Drax Road; North Yorkshire County Council have contacted Mr Harrison (Trees Officer at SDC) and asked him which trees would be acceptable to replace the trees to be removed. He said that we would like field maples.

Neighbourhood Watch signs; -the chairman has put the signs up

Holmlea Brigg Lane-resubmission of plans for dwelling. The Parish Council objected using the same objections as before.

Low Farm Camela Lane-Conversion of a barn to a dwelling house. No objection.

Concern was expressed that should more of the barns be converted that Camela Lane was unsuitable for increased traffic. The road is a single-track road and the surface is breaking up. If more barns are converted the Parish Council felt that passing places should be made on the lane.

Village Hall: Mrs O'Connell confirmed that the Parish Council is still Trustees for the Village Hall. The village Hall Committee decided to close the hall due to lack of customers.

Weight Watchers and Brownies have moved out. Only Rainbows are left using the hall and they only pay £7.00 a week.

The Village Hall has been closed because it is no longer viable. The condition of the building is poor. It needs refurbishment and a new roof.

. The responsibility for the Village Hall has been handed back to the Parish Council.

The current Insurance Company may not carry on insuring the hall, as it is empty.

There will be a standing charge for water and electricity. The clerk to ring the insurance companies and the Charity Commission to seek advice on the situation.

Mosquito on Shops: there is a possibility that the Parish Council could obtain funding for the mosquito from CIPS

Youth Shelter: Parish Council looked at the shelters provided by Record Play group. The Parish Council could install a shelter up to 4 metres without planning permission.

Fencing erected by Yorkshire Water outside Burtons Farm: a complaint was made about the unsightly state of this fencing. The chairman agreed that he would remove it.
