You could qualify if you are in receipt of the following:

Child Tax Credit (with an income of £15,860 or less)

Working Tax Credit (with an income of £15,860 or less) and have any of the following:

- Has parental responsibility for a child under 16 who ordinarily resides with that person. (16 or over but under 20 and in full time education[†] other than higher education)
- Disabled worker element
- Severe disability element
- Aged 60 years or over

Income Support (IS) and

- Has parental responsibility for a child under 16 who ordinarily resides with that person. (16 or over but under 20 and in full time education[†] other than higher education)
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) (which must include a disability or severe disability element for a child or young person).
- Disabled Child Premium.
- Disability Premium enhanced disability or severe disability element premium.
- Pensioner Premium higher pension premium or enhanced pensioner premium.

Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (that includes a work related activity or support component)

Pension Credit

- Guaranteed Pension Credit
- Savings Pension Credit

Income-based Job Seekers Allowance (JSA) and;

- Has parental responsibility for a child under 16 who ordinarily resides with that person. (16 or over but under 20 and in full time education[†] other than higher education)
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) (which must include a disability or severe disability element for a child or young person).
- Disabled Child Premium.
- Disability Premium enhanced disability or severe disability element premium.
- Pensioner Premium higher pension premium or enhanced pensioner premium.

[†] only eligible if the child/young adult is completing 6th form 'A' level or BTEC however does not include a degree course or university study.
